## **Cornfield Annual wildflower mix**

A one year mix of 4 species. Annual species Corn Poppy, Corn Marigold, Cornflower and Mayweed were once a familiar sight in arable fields but modern farming methods have made them much less common. They are suitable for a sunny, well-drained position where you would like them to flower (as you cannot transplant them once sown). Sown in spring, this mix will flower in the same year. Sown in autumn they flower the next year. They will only flower once and new seed will need to be re-sown if you would like them to grow again.

Mix well and sow at 2g/m<sup>2</sup>.
