Green Roof Mix (87% wildflowers/13% grasses)

These are low-growing species, tolerant of dry conditions for a wide range of green roofs with 100mm+ of substrate. As it is made up of a wide range of native (& wild origin) flowering species and grasses this will ensure that your roof provides maximum diversity. There are 20 wildflower & 3 grass species in this mix.
